

What factors are the most important to you in a football club?



CLUB FACILITIES

The majority of our facilities were rated above average however the fields and toilets could be improved. So in the off season we are compiling quotes to upgrade the downstairs toilet area which will hopefully include an accessible bathroom and a much nicer space. We have also been working with the council to fix up the fields which will be done over 2 years. This summer field 1 is being fixed whilst next summer field 2 and the junior fields will be fixed. We have also hired Te Mete park for 3 evenings during the week for next season as a training ground. This involved taking over ownership of the lights at Te Mete Park which we will upgrade. All of this will hopefully allow the fields at Merrilands Domain to remain in better condition during the season.


OTHER POINTS
