# Recent Results

## Taranaki Premier League

Pepper Construction NP Rangers have recovered from that devastating 4-0 defeat to FC Western a few weeks ago to go unbeaten in six league and cup matches. Wins over FDMC, Woodleigh, Hawera and Inglewood in the league and a victory against Kaponga in the Duff Rosebowl have set the second half of the season. The only slight blip was last weekend's return fixture with FDMC which resulted in a 1-1 draw, the school side putting in a sterling effort for a deserved draw. With numbers stretched over the past few weeks, it has seen Jeff Yates, the regular goalkeeper appearing in defence with Daryl Foreman looking after the gloves. The stand out performer for the team so far has been Liam Dungey, while Niall Leggett has been a consistent performer chipping in with several vital goals including last week's draw with FDMC. Having failed in the past couple of years in the Duff Rosebowl, this will be a target for the team. After falling behind to an early goal the team recovered to beat Kaponga quite comfortably 4-1 in round one. In the next round we play Inglewood at home on the 15th July. Today we have a tough game away to Moturoa who remain unbeaten at the top of the league. We lost the Challenge trophy to them earlier in the season. It would be nice for Michael Somers to bring it back!

## Division One

Last time I said we had a contrast in this division. Well it's going the other way now as Treehouse Rangers have only lost once in 7 league games. They regained the Challenge Trophy beating FC Western 4-2 away two weeks ago. Last week saw an emphatic win over FDMC 3-0. In the 1st round of the Duff Rosebowl the team lost to Woodleigh Premis 0-4. Today they are at home to league leaders Kaponga. Dimond Oddbodz Rangers have had a mixed bag of results lately seemingly a sequence of winning one game then losing the next which has seen them slip six points behind Kaponga but remain in second place, which is a great achievement after stepping up a division from last year. 
